The Beulah Outdoor Pool project included a lap pool, children's area, lazy river, waterslide, and zero depth entry pool. There was a 2,600 square foot building that included the men's, women's, and family locker rooms as well as office space and a 1,600 square foot pool equipment building.



Bergstrom Electric started on the project in September of 2008.

The electrical system work itself involved completely wiring the bathhouse and pool equipment building, including the heaters and pool pumps for the waterslide and lazy river as well as grounding the entire project. An unusual challenge was that the entire floor of the locker rooms had electric floor heat - an unusual feature for a building of that size.

The project took a total of 1,364 man-hours to complete and was finished in July of 2009.
