This new 74,870 square foot residence hall on the North Dakota State University campus offers students apartment-style housing in a convenient location.

The building required a 2500 amp 120/208 volt electrical system, 102,570 feet of EMT, 8,190 feet of PVC, and 1600 lights. Bergstrom Electric served as the prime electrical contractor for the project and started work in April of 2007.

Our crews completed the job in 17,400 man-hours in August of 2008. The total electrical construction cost was \$980,000.
