The new WalMart Super Center in Fargo opened in late October of 2009. It is a 189,636 square foot building and contains a full line of groceries, more than 30 merchandise departments, several convenience centers including a pharmacy, vision center, and photo processing center, a hair salon and a Subway.

Bergstrom Electric was the electrical contractor for the project and started work in November of 2008. The electrical system included two 600 amp and two 800 amp distribution panels along with a 3000 amp switchboard. The project also required over 111,500 feet of conduit, 421,500 feet of wire, and 2,242 light fixtures.

It took Bergstrom crews approximately 13,250 man-hours to complete the project at a final electrical construction cost of approx. \$810,000.
